- GAS Tax funding has become a permanent fixture - Township receives increased dollars every year – funding can be used for paving projects each year as a cost saving measure (reducing the kilometres of gravel roads also reduces the amount of grading and the need for dust control)
- Other possible projects for consideration: recycling; septage disposal
