

- b) Navigo will print out location maps identifying missing information –specifically road names and some water access properties. Staff and Councillors will review the maps and add the missing information.
- c) Sue Klatt will continue to pursue Ortho-photography with the Ministry of Natural Resources as this will be another useful layer to add to the civic addressing maps.
- d) The Works Superintendent will contact the Ministry of Transportation to arrange a meeting.
- e) Navigo will complete the location marking for the entire municipality as soon as possible.
- f) It was discussed that some of the posts can be installed on the side roads in preparation of sign installation; it was added that doing this means a return to each location when they go back to put the number on the post.

George Hughes and William Thornback left the meeting, a short recess was called at 8:30p.m. and everyone else returned at 8:45 p.m.

5. Update on Sale of M/L Recreation/Fire Hall Property

Because Mr. Fletcher was not made aware of the fact that the property was on a flood plain, he has backed out of the sale. It was the consensus of council to return Mr. Fletcher’s deposit cheque and to list the property for sale again with Tim Fulford. Water needs to be drained from the pipes and the heat needs to be turned off. Hydro not to be disconnected.
